Counselor in Training

For young women ages 13 – 15

The Counselor in Training Program is a unique opportunity for young women ages 13-15 to receive on the job training by assisting experienced counselors and program instructors in all areas of the camp program. CIT's will develop leadership, communication and socialization skills through active participation in a series of traditional camp components. Space is limited to 5 CIT's per session. Each potential CIT must go through an interview process before being accepted. **\$80 per session in advance.**
