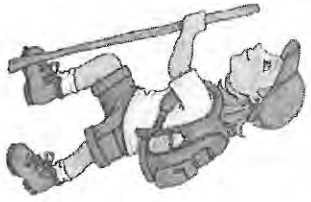

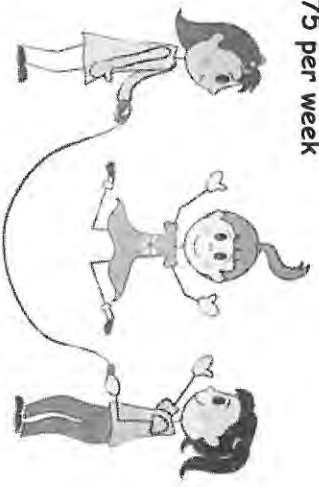

For girls entering Kindergarten - Age 15+

Girls Inc. mission oriented programs in the areas of sports & adventure, self-reliance & life skills, culture & heritage, leadership & community action, careers & life planning, and health & sexuality in addition to traditional camp components of drama, art, nature, sports, swim skills & free swim, and team & social skill building. "Spirit Days" on Tuesdays and special events held every Friday. Girls are separated into units by age. Typically there are 4 units, Unit 1 is 5-6 yrs, Unit 2 is 7-8 yrs, Unit 3 is 9-10 yrs, and Unit 4 is 11+ yrs. Please read parent handbooks for more detailed information.

For young women ages 13-15

The Counselor in Training (CIT) Program is a unique opportunity for young women ages 13-15 to receive on the job training by assisting experienced counselors and program instructors in all areas of the camp program. CIT's will develop leadership, communication, and socialization skills through active participation in a series of traditional camp components. Space is limited to 5 CIT's per week session. Each potential CIT must go through an interview process before being accepted.

- Balance due in advance of each session

FINANCIAL AID:

Financial assistance in the form of campership funds is available for all Brigham Center summer programs, to income eligible families based on a sliding scale.

The goal of Camp Stevenson-Witawentlin is that every child has an enjoyable camp experience. If circumstances change and your child is unable to attend camp, notice must be given 10 days prior to the start date in order to receive a refund. There will be no refund for a session after that time.
